Job Summary

Serving a vital role in the COVID-19 pandemic response for individuals experiencing homelessness, the Edmonton Isolation Facility, operated by Boyle McCauley Health Centre, provides 24/7 shelter and support to individuals needing to isolate due to suspected COVID-19 exposure. The facility offers individuals all required supports to remain safely in isolation – this includes basic comfort needs, food, shelter, and medical care. The LPN, working in conjunction with physicians, nurse practitioners, pharmacy, and shelter support workers, will provide 24/7 nursing care. We are looking for someone who is compassionate and non-judgmental. If you are excited about the rewarding work of providing care to a community that has historically been underserved and underrepresented, we would love to have you join our team!

As the capacity of the Edmonton Isolation Facility is expanding, we are hiring multiple candidates for multiple shift opportunities. While we have flexibility to our scheduling, we are looking for people who are interested in working a regular number of shifts per week, with the ability to vary the shift times as needed.

Key Responsibilities

- Work in an interdisciplinary team to provide medical supports in the shelter setting
- In partnership with physicians and nurse practitioners, providing the following healthcare services:
 - Assessment and triage
 - Basic treatment of injuries and ailments (including woundcare)
 - Laboratory collection, in particular COVID-19 swabbing
 - Medication management (including medication administration and medication assistance)
 - Management of substance misuse disorders

- Be able to respond to urgent medical need, in particular opioid overdose response
- The LPN will also be a key part of the shelter management team, and may be required to fulfill shelter duties including:
 - Monitoring of client isolation spaces
 - Upkeep and maintenance of medical space (including supplies and inventory)
 - Delivery of food and nutrition items
 - Basic cleaning and turnover of isolation spaces
- Will coordinate with inner-city sector partners to facilitate referrals and discharges to and from isolation facility

Qualifications

- Current registration with CLPNA
- Current CPR
- Mandatory vulnerable sector check and suitable criminal record check
- Experience with marginalized populations (e.g. homelessness, detox, treatment facilities, or similar) an asset

Knowledge/Skills

- Able to balance numerous demands and conflicting priorities, strong problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work co-operatively within a multidisciplinary team
- Ability to demonstrate patience and understanding for those with addictions and behavioral disorders
- Strong computer proficiency, with experience with MedAccess EMR an asset
- Excellent communication skills.
- Has a good understanding of trauma-informed care, and must be able to operate within a harm reduction model of care

Salary: an excellent compensation package commensurate to experience will be provided. Shift differential will apply for evening, overnight, and weekend shifts.
