The BMHC achieves this by providing the highest standard of evidence-informed and client focused inter-professional care. We collaborate with our clients to address the broad determinants of health.

Job Description

BMHC Licensed Practical Nurses are a vital component of the Team Based care at BMHC. Clinical teams of nurses, physicians, nurse practitioners, medical office assistants, outreach workers, health advocates, mental health therapists, and other professionals offer comprehensive, wrap-around care to Edmonton's most marginalized population. Nursing staff are required to work to full-scope of practice within a primary health care setting to serve all aspects of client needs. LPNs are leaders and independent practitioners at BMHC, working collaboratively to ensure high quality care, continuity of health services, and all possible social and medical supports for clients.

NB: This position will predominantly be assigned to the "second-shift" at BMHC's main clinic after May 2022 – this position works 1200-2000 on weekdays, with an occasional weekend rotation for a half-day on Saturday from 0800-1230. Until that time, the position will be Mon-Fri between the hours of 0800-1700.

Key Responsibilities

- Work in an interdisciplinary team to provide medical supports in a primary care setting
- In collaboration with the healthcare team, providing the following healthcare services:
 - Assessment and triage

- Basic treatment of injuries and ailments (including woundcare)
- Laboratory collection
- Medication management (including medication administration and medication assistance)
- Management of substance misuse disorders
- Continuity of care
- Client advocacy
- Be an essential part of clinic workflow, including managing patients through all aspects of their interactions at BMHC, managing appointments and information within the Electronic Medical Record, and providing direct and indirect supports through the clinic space

Qualifications

- Current registration with CLPNA
- Current CPR
- Mandatory vulnerable sector check and suitable criminal record check
- Experience with marginalized populations (e.g. homeless serving sector, social service agencies) an asset

Knowledge/Skills

- Able to balance numerous demands and conflicting priorities, strong problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work co-operatively within a multidisciplinary team
- Ability to demonstrate patience and understanding for those with addictions and behavioral disorders

- Has a good understanding of trauma-informed care, and must be able to operate within a harm reduction model of care
